Dear Green Market sellers,

The third season of the Green Market at the Corinth Depot will be kicking off on April 2. We hope that all of you will plan to join us!

The April 2 Green Market will be held in conjunction with the Crossroads Chili Cook-off. Like last year, the ONLY vendors at either event will be Green Market sellers. We are, however, making a few other changes. The Chili Cook-Off runs until 5:00 p.m. This year, Green Market sellers are required to stay the whole time. If you are not able to stay from 8:00 – 5:00, please do not set-up. The 8:00 – 5:00 hours are ONLY for the April 2 market; subsequent markets will be 8:00 – 2:00 as usual. Also for April 2, Green Market sellers will enter on Wick Street. The Tourism office entrance will be blocked off. You will enter on Wick, unload and move your car to another location.

A few changes have been made to the Green Market policies. Please read this letter and enclosed application thoroughly. When you sign the application, it indicates that you have read these guidelines and agree to them. These guidelines will be enforced and are in place to uphold the integrity of the Green Market, with fairness to all sellers and shoppers alike.

- ALL items must be handcrafted or homegrown! If for any reason, any member of the Green Market committee feels that your item is not handcrafted or homegrown, you will be asked to remove that item. This is at the committee's discretion and will be strictly enforced.
- NO night-before set-up. NO exceptions. Set-up is ONLY allowed the morning of market.
- Spots may not be reserved. Green Market is a first-come, first-serve market. If you want a good spot, be there first - around 6:30 a.m. (NOT the night before).
- Should you be asked to leave the Market for any reason, your payment will NOT be refunded.
- NO selling from the back of your vehicle unless you have a detachable trailer and have prior approval. This includes produce sellers.
- DO NOT sign up if you plan to leave early (see hours above). Should you run out of inventory, take orders or walk around and support your fellow artisans.
- You may not park your vehicle on the CACVB or Museum lot after you have unloaded. No exceptions.
- The Green Market enforces any regulations set forth by the Health Department at anytime. If you are planning to sell any food items besides produce, please call prior to completing your application (662.287.8300).

Market will be held on the first Saturday of the month with the season ending in October. Plans for RED Green Market will be announced later. All items sold must be handcrafted or homegrown within a 100-mile radius of Corinth, Mississippi and sellers provide their own tents, tables, chairs, etc. No electricity.

The entire season (excluding RED Green Market) is \$60.00 (this means that you commit to selling at each Green Market held this season.) Individual Market days are \$10 if you pay before Friday; if you pay the Friday before or the day of Market, the fee is \$15. Anyone selling 90% produce may participate for free. Please indicate this on your application.
